Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must:

- be a Canadian Citizen or permanent resident
- be a graduate of J.A. William High School in Lac La Biche, Alberta
- show empathy and compassion to others
- be enrolled full-time in a post-secondary or apprenticeship program – no less than a two year program
- be enrolled in a post secondary study dealing with animal science or animal care
- be in financial need

Application Procedures

Application must be received by June 30.

Include with the application:

- an official transcript of high school marks from Alberta Education
- a letter of acceptance from the accredited post-secondary institution
- two or three paragraphs describing themselves, their aspirations, goals and financial needs
- a letter of recommendation

Once the Application for the *Mary Ellen Kruger Memorial Scholarship* has been received, the following procedures will take place:

- Confirmation of the application will be sent to the applicant
- The selection committee will review the application in August
- The applicant will be notified via a letter from the Associate Superintendent – Student Services

* Applicants must inform the Assistant Superintendent of any changes to the application form.

- A member from the Kruger family
- The Assistant Superintendent of Northern Lights School Division No. 69, or his designate
- A Representative from J.A. Williams High School

* The committee reserves the right to defer the scholarship to another year if they deem that a suitable applicant has not applied.
