

The Spirit Week leading up to Halloween at CLHS was great for school spirit. Here are a few staff Halloween pics.














## Baking Option

# Labrador Heritage


Mr. Webb shared a part of his heritage - all different types of animals found on his childhood home in Nain, Labrador.








## Our juniors placed 5th out of 28 teams.

We entered 4 teams who competed with schools from all over Alberta



























## Cardboard Chariot Races

### Time to Remember ...








