## Enhancing student physical development with Track & Field Day





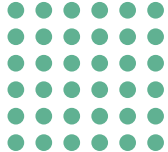

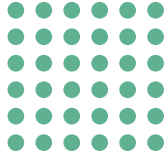
**Duclos

- C2 Walking Track

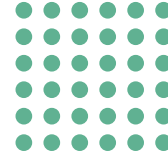

JAWS Staff worked on Positive Behaviours and Supports.

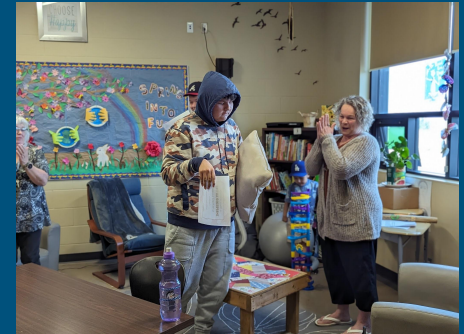
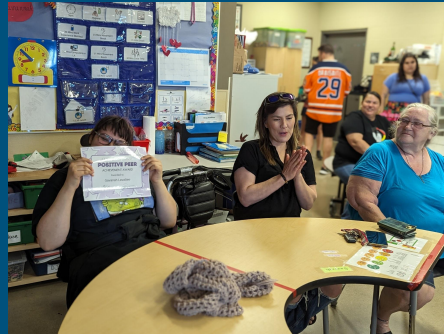
We analyzed Mental Health Survey data, Provincial Diploma results, as well as Provincial Achievement Test results.

Life Skills students at JAWS invited family members and special guests to celebrate accomplishments and successes - Huge thank you to the team that supports our Life Skills students.

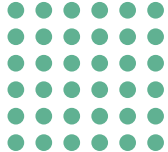




# Enhanced Learning Opportunities at JAWS

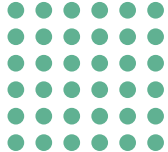






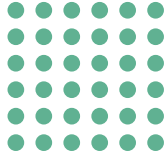
