SURVEY RESULTS

Start of Year

• Parents and staff prefer for students to start school after Labour Day.

Length of Breaks

 Parents and staff prefer a combination of individual noschool days and extended breaks throughout the year.

Spring Break

- There was no clear preference for the timing of Spring Break.
- Parents and staff wanted the division to align breaks with other local school jurisdictions when feasible.

November Break

• There was no clear preference for a November break.

APPROVED CALENDAR

Start of Year

• Students will start school on Tuesday, September 2, following Labour Day.

Length of Breaks

 The calendar features a combination of individual no-school days, no-school days aligned with holidays to create 4-day weekends, a week-long spring break, and a two-week winter break.

Spring Break

• Spring Break is aligned with the Catholic school division, and occurs the week leading up to Easter.

November Break

• A November break was not added to the calendar.

OTHER CALENDAR HIGHLIGHTS

4-day long weekends for students in September (Truth and Reconciliation Day), October (Thanksgiving), November (Remembrance Day), and May (Victoria Day).
180 instructional days (2 semesters of 90 days each).
