

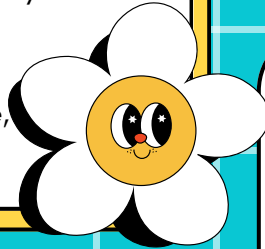
Wandering River School

- Please join us on June 25 at 11:00, everyone is welcome!

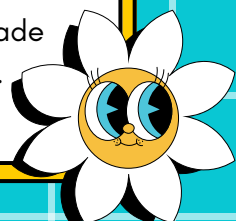

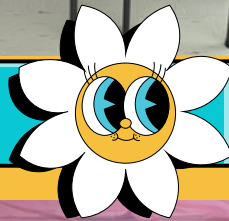


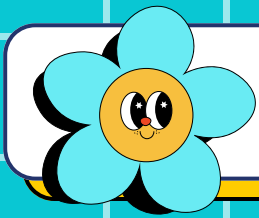


Easter Fun!

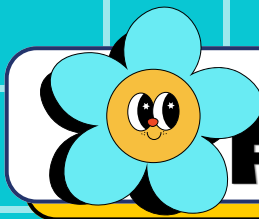

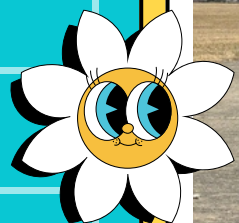
