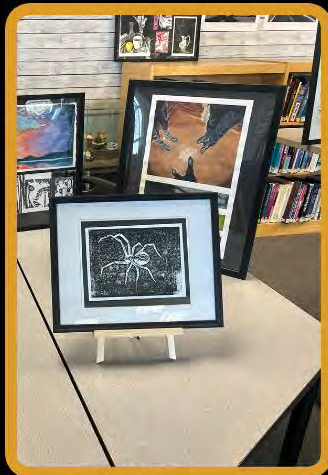




Royals Open House 2025

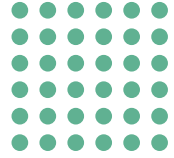

MOCK ELECTION

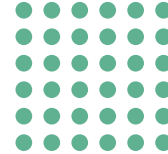
