
Student Vote Canada 2025



Glendon Cake Auction





We were blessed by some community Baba's that came in to do a craft with our students for Mother's Day! They did a great job and all the moms loved their gifts!












JAWS students participated in the Let's Go Rural Healthcare event at Portage College. Students had the opportunity to experience various healthcare related career options.


