



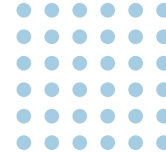

Great work Wolves!







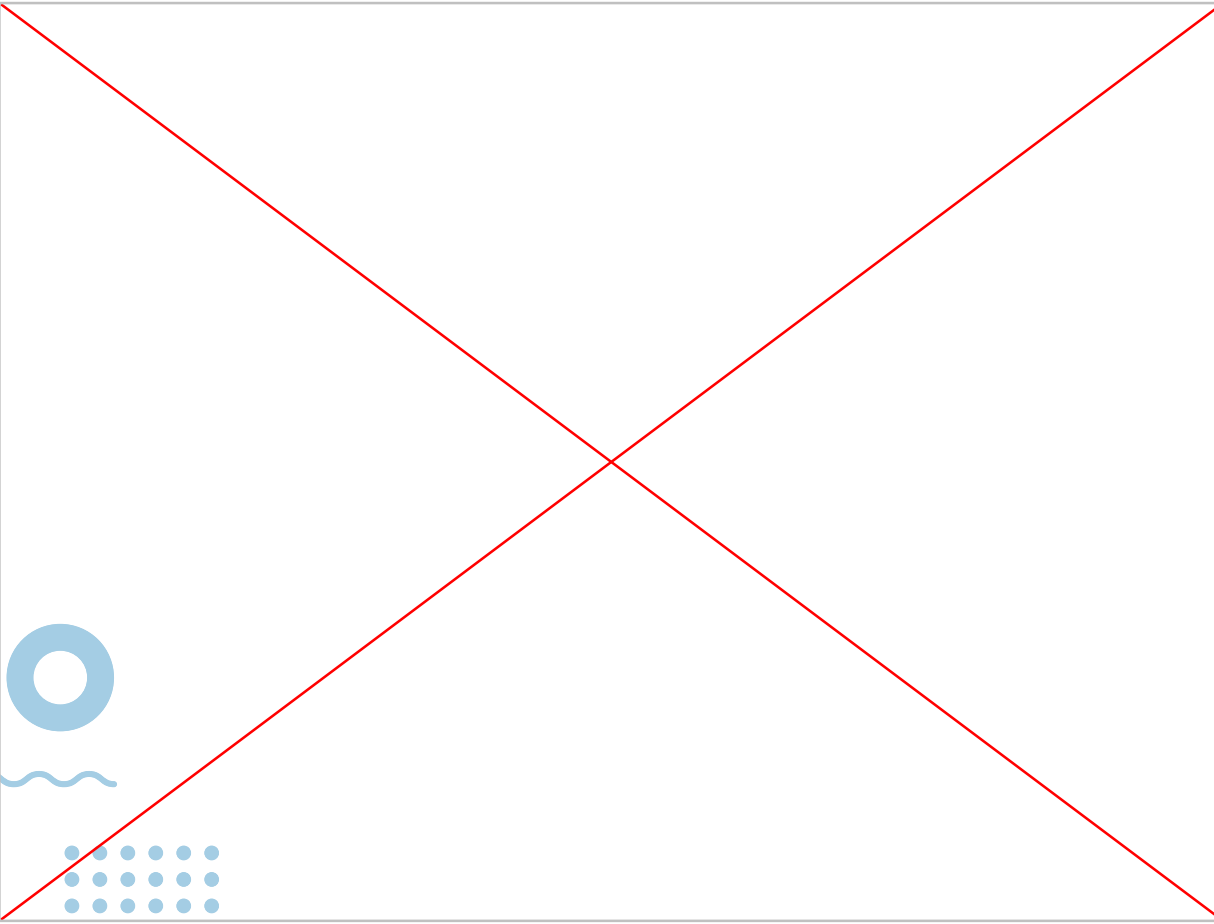
